2009 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

The Rotary Club of Parkland-Spanaway invites high school seniors from the area to complete an application form for one of seven \$1,500 scholarships awarded each school year. All candidates must currently attend high school within the Bethel or Franklin Pierce School District boundaries.

All scholarships are in the form of certificates of award, conditioned upon the enrollment of the student in an undergraduate course in an accredited two or four-year college or vocational institution. Upon receiving notice of enrollment, a check jointly payable to the college and the student will be forwarded to the college.

Selection Criteria

Awards will be based on the following:

1. Community involvement and work experience
2. School leadership and involvement
3. GPA/Academic standing
4. Financial need
5. Application (neatness, thoroughness, completeness, written statement)
6. Unique factors
7. Recommendations

Candidates applying for this scholarship must submit the following:

- A. A Completed application form
- B. A statement (in addition to the attached requested information) of not more than 500 words prepared by the applicant. This statement should summarize school and community activities and accomplishments, work experience, the applicants goals and objectives for higher education, the reason they believe they are qualified for this scholarship award, and the need for financial assistance.
- C. One letter from a community leader, not related to the applicant (no more than one page).
- D. One letter of endorsement for a school official (teacher or counselor)
- E. Copies of high school transcripts and SAT, ACT, or other tests taken

All incomplete applications will be disqualified.
